Nessie's Reel

(Scotland)

Nessie's Reel is an 8 x 32 bar reel for three couples. It was devised by Ralph Sizer and appears in \underline{A} Yankee Sampler. Marianne Taylor presented the dance at the 1992 University of the Pacific Folk Dance Camp. Marianne described it as serpentine as its namesake: the Loch Ness Monster.

CASSETTE: Muckle Carfuffle FAC CS134 Side B/3 "Set of Reels"

2/4 meter

Any suitably phrased 32 bar reel.

FORMATION: Set of 4 couples in longways formation.

STEPS and STYLING:

Bow and curtsey*, hands across*, cast up*, cast down*, move up*, move down*,

rights and lefts*.

Skip change of step*, beg R, used throughout the dance.

* Described in Scottish Glossary of <u>Steps & Styling</u>, published by the Folk Dance Federation of California, Inc.

MUSTC

2/4 meter

PATTERN

Measures

Chord INTRODUCTION M bow and W curtsey to ptr.

I. HANDS ACROSS; WOMAN CAST, MAN FOLLOW

- 1-4 Cpls 1 and 2 dance right hands across once around. W l end facing out on W side.
- 5-6 W 1, followed by M 1, cast down one place.
- 7-8 W 1 cross the set to M 2 place, facing out. M 1 end in W 2 place. Cpl 2 move up.
- 9-12 Cpls 1 and 3 dance left hands across once around. W 1 end facing out on M side.
- 13-14 W 1, followed by M 1, cast down one place.
- 15-16 Cpl l end in the ctr of the set facing up and take nearer hands. Cpl 3 move up.

II. LEAD UP AND CAST; LEAD DOWN AND CAST

- 1-2 Cpl l dance up the ctr to above Cpl 2.
- 3-4 Releasing hands, Cpl l cast down one place on own side.

Nessie's Reel - pg 2.

5-6 Cpl l dance into ctr of set, M l going between M 2 and 3, W l between W 2 and 3. Taking nearer hands, dance down between Cpl 3.

7-8 Releasing hands, Cpl 1 cast up to 2nd place on own side. Cpl 3 move down to 3rd place.

III. RIGHTS AND LEFTS

1 - 8Cpls 2 and 1 dance rights and lefts.

Cpl l repeat the dance from 2nd place dancing with Cpls 3 and 4. Cpl l go 32 meas

to the bottom of the set on the outside as the new top cpl begins.

192 meas Dance pattern as written with Cpls 2, 3 and 4 active each in turn.

Chord M bow and W curtsey to ptr.



One of the master teachers for the Institute is Michael Ginsburg of New York. With both parents as folk dancers, Michael started young, took up folk dancing seriously in his early teens, and did his first teaching at the Hermans' Folk Dance House. Now 25 years later, he is on the faculty of the Bank Street College of Education in New York, conducts a Balkan class at the Ethnic Folk Arts Center and an international session at Hungarian House, and his teaching style has made him a sought-after instructor at folk dance camps. He is also an accomplished musician who directs Zlatne Uste, a ten-piece band which performed three times as guests of Yugoslavia at the annual gathering of brass bands in Guca, Serbia. Having studied with Pece Atanasovski in Macedonia and done field research in Yugoslavia and Bulgaria, Michael will present dances from the Ballkans.

The other teacher is Thea Huijgen of Washington state, formerly of the Netherlands, where she performed with the sole professional folk dance ensemble, International Folkloristisch Danstheater. She worked with specialists from all over Europe and was the recipient of a grant to study in Bulgaria. Then for ten years she directed her own dance school, in addition to directing a folk dance perform-

ing group. She was also a member of Praznik, which had a Bulgarian repertoire and was co-directled by Jaap Leegwater. Since immigrating in 1984, Thea has continued to teach international folk dance as well as a number of other dance styles for groups, colleges and schools on the West Coast. At Statewide, she will enhance the Federation repartoire by teaching Dutch and Russian dances.

The free Beginner's Institute takes the place of the spring beginner's festival and will be at the introductory level. The master teachers will not be involved in it. It will be of no interest to experienced folk dancers, who will want to attend the simultaneous dance party in the other gym, instead.


