Dear Board Members:

I am writing to you to volunteer to create a World Wide Web site on the internet on behalf of the Folk Dance Federation of California, Inc. (Federation). The web site would be a new publication of the Federation that would deliver Federation information to interested dancers who have access to the internet. The web site would be used for advertising purposes to attract new members, sell existing paper-based publications and to promote folk dancing by helping making available the publications of the Federation.

The following items could be available to interested people who "visit" the web site:

- General information about the Federation;
- Advertisements about upcoming Federation activities;
- Historical information about Folk Dancing;
- Costume research information;
- Information about councils and individual clubs where real live dancing is available;
- Dance index to find dances based on origin, type, skill level, etc.
- Dance descriptions.

As you can see, the web site has the potential to include all currently written materials of the Federation. These materials would gradually be made available and would include information about how to order the materials in paper form.

If you would like to proceed with this project, I would need to have permission of the Federation to reproduce the copyrighted materials on the web site. Reproducing these materials would not remove the copyright protection that the Federation has on these documents.

Initially there would be no cost to the federation. I can provide the basic services required at my own expense. In the future the Federation may consider establishing an account at an approximate monthly cost of \$45 and a one time start up cost of \$70. I can discuss the advantages of this situation, if you are interested in pursuing this.
