SPANISH CIRCLE (Waltz) American

Music

Any well-phrased waltz, in moderate tempo.

Formation

Two couples form a set. The sets form a large circle, with the No. 1 couple facing clockwise, and the No. 2 couple facing counterclockwise around the circle.

Steps

Waltz*, Waltz Balance, Lift.

Measure	I. Balance and Change Partners Couples stand side by side with inside hands joined.	Start 2 2
1 - 2	Each starting on outside ft., balance fwd. and bwd. (Arms are swung fwd. and bwd. with each step.)	Meas. 1
3 - 4	With two waltz steps exchange partners. The M takes opposite W's L hand with his R, taking her to a new position in the set. Couples are now facing inside and outside of large circle. Note: The W may turn under the M's R arm.	Start 2 2 2 1 2 Meas. 3

17 - 20	II. Star and Circle Join R hands, forming star, and waltz clock- wise four waltz steps.	b 4.
21 - 24	Return with L hand star counterclockwise four waltz steps.	Start (2)
25 - 28 29 - 32	Join hands and circle L four waltz steps. Return four waltz steps to the R.	Meas. 2007
33 - 44	III. Couples Waltz and Progress In closed position couples waltz 1-1/2 times around the opposite couple. Note: Waltz should be preceded by a lift.	
45 - 48	which is done by the M taking a short step bwd. on his L and the W fwd. on her R (ct. 1) then lift on the ball of the ft. (cts. 2,3). Couples continue to waltz in direction which they were originally facing, meeting oncoming couple and forming a new set.
