There was one conflict--the Marin Folk Dance Council Blue Lakes Camp and the Sonoma Festival. Ernie asked that Frank Bacher and Al Heinrich meet after the general meeting to resolve the conflict.

At this time Frank Bacher, President of the Redwood Council welcomed all present and stated that refreshments would be served after the meeting.

Institute - Frank Bacher reported that 52 had attended the Institute plus the teachers. Bill D Alvy reported that the next Federation Institute would be in San Jose in January, 1976. Before that time there were several things that should be "ironed out".

Director of Publications - Max Horn said that September 30 was the deadline for changes in the Costume Calendar as he hoped to have them ready for the Fresno Festival.

Legislative - Lawrence Jerue reported that the By-Laws were ready to be presented to the Executive Board. The next Executive Board Meeting will be at the home of Walt and Vi Dexheimer on October 26th at which time the By-Law changes would be presented and the Treasurer's Ball would be discussed.

Let's Dance - Linda Horn reported that October 1st would be the deadline for news and articles for the next issue. She asked everyone to cooperate as she was starting College at the end of September.

Insurance- Lawrence Jerue reported he hoped to have the new rates before the end of the year. He had secured liability insurance for the office equipment and volumes. The cost had been \$35.00 for \$4,000.

Statewide 76 - Ruth Melville stated she had kept everything at a low profile until after PAYS. Centennial Hall should be completed by Dec. 31st and then it would be "full speed ahead". In the meantime there was a lot of work to be done.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Ernie reported that the Redwood Council had secured \$282.00 in Let's Dance advertising so he urged all to patronize those who had advertised.

Millie von Kinsky reported that she had sent out 83 letters asking that the enclosed questionnaire be completed and returned to her. The tabulated results will be used in selecting dances for a review workshop and for dances on the program for the Beginner Festival. The Review of 6-8 beginner dances will be held on Sunday, November 9, 1975 from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. at the Ahmes Temple, 3291 School St., Oakland --the same day and place as the Treasurer's Ball. There will be no charge. The Beginner Festival will be on Sunday afternoon, April 11, 1976. Frank Bacher, who is handling the music for the Treasurer's Ball will also handle the music for the Workshop.

NEW BUSINESS

Ray Olson reported that he was not able to secure the cooperation from clubs under the sponsorship of the Recreation Departments. It was difficult to get the names of those attending the classes.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Frank Bacher said the Petaluma Folk Dancers had had to move their meeting place from Pengrove to the Kennilworth School in Petaluma. Their parties would be on the same date and at the same time. Only the place had been changed.

Frank announced tickets had been distributed for the refreshments.

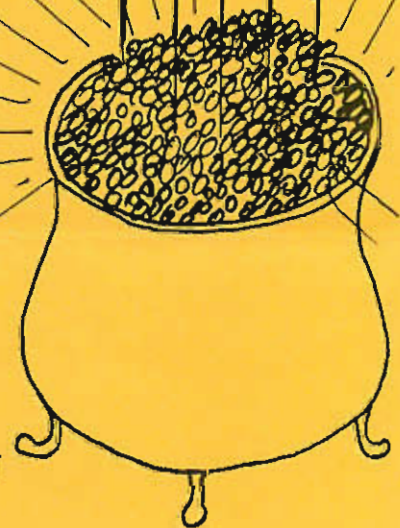
