FOLK DANCE FEDERATION OF CALIFORNIA, INC. ASSEMBLY MEETING MINUTES HARVEST FESTIVAL FRESNO, CALIFORNIA OCTOBER 22, 2000

Michael Norris, President of the Fresno Council, welcomed the group to the Harvest Festival.

President Craig Blackstone called the meeting to order at 11:55 a.m. He announced that the sign-in sheet showed a quorum was present and asked for approval of the minutes.

Elsa Bacher corrected the following dates under Upcoming Festivals and Events:

- 1. The Sweetheart Festival is to be held on February 11, 2001, not the 10th;
- 2. The Festival of the Oaks is to be held on February 25, 2001, not the 27th;
- 3. The Camellia Festival is to be held on March 10 and 11, 2001.

She also pointed out an ambiguous sentence in the Membership report which confuses the amount of dues paid by Clubs, Associate members, and "Let's Dance" subscribers. To clarify:

- 1. Clubs pay a flat annual fee of \$25.00, not \$22.50;
- 2. Associate members pay annual dues of \$22.50;
- 3. Subscribers to the "Let's Dance" magazine pay an annual \$17.50.

Frank Bacher moved and Jim Oxford seconded the minutes be approved as corrected. Motion passed.

REPORTS

PRESIDENT: President Craig Blackstone reported that since the last Assembly meeting, the Federation has received a \$6000.00, (six thousand dollar), gift in memory of Ace Smith and that the Executive Board has approved those monies be set up as a base for a Scholarship Fund which is to be funded by the interest from this gift.

Craig also reported the receipt of \$1240.34, (one thousand two hundred forty dollars and thirty four cents), the second annuity of the D'Alvy gift and said there may be a third annuity.

Elsa Bacher moved that the Ace Smith Memorial donation of \$6000.00 be put into a Scholarship Fund. Frank Bacher seconded. Discussion included that a Scholarship Committee be reinstalled; that it is the desire of the Assembly to use only the interest of the Fund for scholarship purposes. Motion passed.

Craig also reported he had received an inquiry from the Peninsula Council asking for \$100.00, (one hundred dollars), financial help because their Institute last year lost money because of \$750.00 hall rental costs. This is one of the two yearly Federation Institutes. Martha Froelich moved that the Federation pay \$100.00, (one hundred), to the Peninsula Council to help them with their January Federation Institute 2001. Frank Bacher voiced a second. Motion carried.

It was clarified that each Council is responsible for hosting one festival per year and its institute if any. The Federation hosts two festivals, the Treasurer's Ball and the Beginners Festival and sponsors two institutes per year, the one at the October Harvest Festival and the one at the January Peninsula Heritage Festival. The Federation Institute Committee selects the dances to be taught at the two Federation sponsored institutes. President Craig

thinks it is important that at least one institute be tied to the Folk Dance Camp.

Elsa moved to reconsider the vote for approving \$100.00, (one hundred dollars), for the Peninsula Council. The motion for reconsideration passed. Elsa then moved to amend the motion to read as follows, that the Federation pay 50 %, (fifty percent), of the hall rental for the Federation Institutes. It was seconded by Frank Bacher. The Assembly voted to pass the amendment to the motion. The motion as amended was then passed.

Craig read a written report received from Naomi Lidicker of calls received since the Federation phone was installed in her home. Almost 70%, (seventy percent), are computer instigated telemarketing calls.

The last item in the President's report was an inquiry from Bob Barckley, Vice President of the International Dance Association of San Diego. He sent the goals and objectives of his organization and requested the goals and objectives of the Federation.

VICE PRESIDENT: No report.

RECORDING SECRETARY: No report.

TREASURER: Treasurer Page Masson read her report. (Report attached) and encouraged everyone to attend December 3 Treasurer's Ball.

MEMBERSHIP: Chairperson Sidney Messer moved that Genevieve Pereira be given a lifetime complimentary membership in honor of her many years of service to the Federation. Mel Mann voiced a second. Motion passed. Vice President Greg Mitchell suggested the Federation write a letter to her to that effect.

PUBLICATIONS: Absent. President Craig said that Chairperson Joel Bruxvoort is awaiting the publication early in the new year of the "Addendum to the Pronunciation Guide and Index".
