MUSIC:	Records: Imperial 1036-A; World of Fun, M 110; World of Fun 4.
FORMATION:	Circle of cpls, ptrs facing with both hands joined (MR with WL and ML with WR), M back to ctr of circle.
STEPS AND STYLING:	Step-swing*, step-draw, waltz*. *Described in Volumes of Folk Dances from Near and Far, published by Folk Dance Federation of California, Inc., 1095 Market Street, Rm. 213, San Francisco, California 94103.
MUSIC 3/4	PATTERN
Measures 1-4	INTRODUCTION. No action. I. STEP-SWING AND TURN UNDER ARM
1	Beginning ML-WR, dance one step-swing in LOD (step ct 1, swing ct 2, hold ct 3).
2	Repeat action of meas 1 (Fig I) in opp direction, starting MR-WL.
3	Release MR-WL hand. M step swd L with L ft (ct 1), draw R ft to L (cts $2,3$). At the same time W turn R under her R arm with 3 steps (RLR) progressing in LOD.
4	M repeat step-draw to L while W completes R turn to finish facing her ptr, stepping L (ct 1), R (cts $2,3$).
5–8	Repeat action of meas $1-4$ in opp direction, with M turning R under his R arm and W dancing 2 step-draw steps to her L.
	II. STEP-DRAW AND WALTZ
9-10	In closed pos dance 2 step-draw steps to ML-WR, progressing LOD.
11-12	Dance 2 step-draw steps to MR-WL, moving RLOD.
13-16	Still in closed pos, cpl dance 4 waltz steps, turning CW and progressing LOD. W may spin to her R on last waltz step.
	${\hbox{{\tt NOTE}}}\colon$ This is usually danced progressively with W turning to her R and progressing in LOD to new ptr on last 2 waltz steps.

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
