		II. CENTER AND BACK
В	9	Cpls in closed pos facing ctr of circle dance a two-step twd ctr, starting ML, WR.
	10	Continue twd ctr of circle with 2 walking steps (M-RL; W-LR).
	11-12	Repeat action of meas $9-10$ (Fig II), moving bwd twd outside of circle without changing pos and still facing ctr of circle. M start R, W L.
	13-16	With 4 two-steps, starting ML and WR, cpls progress CCW around circle while turning CW.
	9-16 repeated	Repeat action of meas 9-16 (Fig. II).
		III. GRAND RIGHT AND LEFT
A	1-8	Ptrs face and offering R hands to each other do a Grand R and L with two-steps.
