# FOLK DANCE FEDERATION OF CALIFORNIA, INC. ASSEMBLY MEETING MINUTES BLOSSOM FESTIVAL SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA APRIL 29, 2001

President Craig Blackstone called the meeting to order at 11:46 a.m. A quorum was present.

Joel Bruxvoort welcomed all to the Blossom Festival and announced a lunch would be available.

## **OFFICER REPORTS**

PRESIDENT: President Craig asked for corrections to the March 11 Camellia Festival Assembly minutes. Mel Mann moved the minutes be approved as submitted. Sharen Skorup seconded the motion and it passed.

President Craig explained that not quite enough interest had accrued from the funds dedicated for scholarship purposes to fund even one half-scholarship for this summer's Stockton Folk Dance Camp. After discussion at the March 11 Executive Board meeting, Irene Oxford moved to recommend the Assembly approve two half-scholarships and that because there is no Scholarship Committee at this time, the recommendations be submitted to the President for this year. Mel Mann voiced a second and the motion passed.

Craig announced this would be the last meeting of his term as president. He said he had enjoyed serving and thanked members for their service. He had to leave for rehearsal and turned the meeting over to Vice President Greg Mitchell.

VICE PRESIDENT: Vice President Greg said he has a few more committee positions to fill.

SECRETARY: Secretary Laila Messer reported cost of a round trip fare on a Greyhound Bus from San Francisco to Las Vegas is \$118.00. If bought a week in advance the round trip price is \$69.00 (not refundable.) The 683 mile trip would take about fourteen hours with possible lay-overs in Los Angeles which could be as short as 30 minutes or as long as 2 1/2 hours depending on departure time. Interest in such a trip was less than minimal.

TREASURER: Treasurer Page Masson read the Treasurer's report of March 1 to April 21. (Report enclosed.) Jim Oxford moved the report be accepted. Sidney Messer seconded. Report accepted.

MEMBERSHIP: Chairperson Sidney Messer reported 215 Associate members, 163 subscribers. 64 clubs, and 29 complimentary memberships making a total of 407.

PUBLICATIONS: Chairperson Joel Bruxvoort said the Federation is about to go on line with credit card billing abilities and with no commitment. The items that are currently out of stock will be reprinted. He also reported the Index and Pronunciation Guide is approaching completion.
